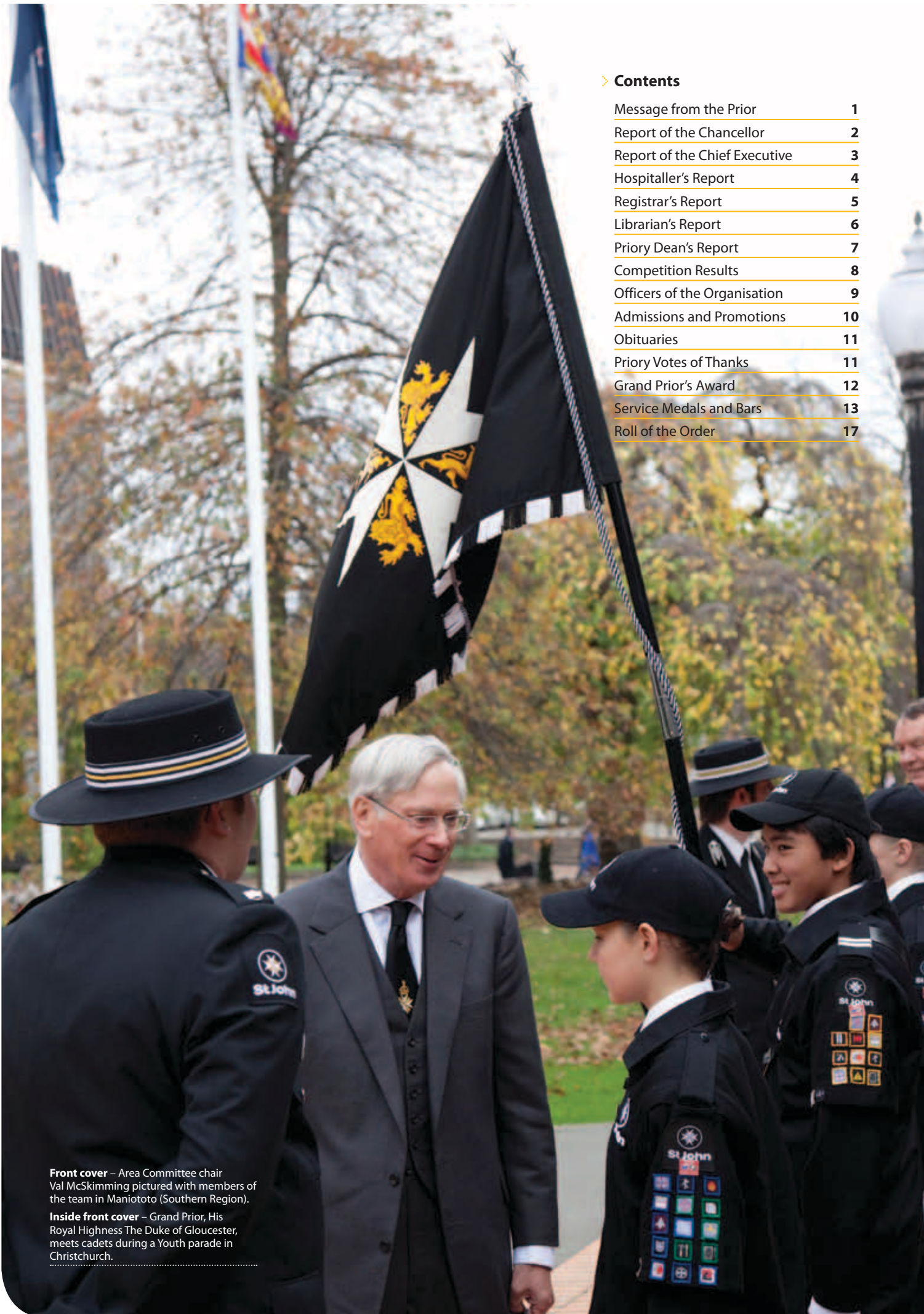

St John has cared for New Zealand communities for 125 years

All members are committed to helping their fellow New Zealanders – from our youngsters, the Penguins and Cadets, right through to our longest serving members. An indication of that special commitment is that 1,993 members have given over 20 years of service to St John and to their communities.

Opportunities and challenges ahead

St John operates a sophisticated, diverse, vital, national organisation within the New Zealand health sector. Demand for our services is growing rapidly – technology, drugs and procedures are changing the way we do things and as a community we are ageing. At best, funding for our services is finite and limited. During the past 125 years, St John has fronted these issues and has often led innovation, specifically in the area of community-based services. The challenge for the Board and the Executive Management Group will be to continue this leadership role and meeting changing and growing community needs, while transforming services.

We can be immensely proud of what we have achieved over the past 125 years and of the unique and valuable contribution St John people make caring for others in need. We can, I believe, also be very

International role

St John will play a key role in the future delivery of healthcare in New Zealand. We will continue to evolve and innovate to do that.

A year of good progress

Through the efforts of our members in providing care for the public our community profile remained highly visible. We made solid progress commercially, our fundraising was effective and we continued on the path we have been on for the past decade, simplifying and streamlining business processes and practices and consolidating our support and financial systems.

Preparing for the future

We took steps to drive unity and consistency in our decision-making by developing our *Statement of strategic intent 2010 – 2014* in a process that involved all Boards. We also re-aligned our senior leadership team to ensure the correct focus and decided to amalgamate our Central and Midland regions into a new Central Region. These are developments that will better position St John for the future.

Changing how we deliver services

It is clear that St John must change and adapt our health service delivery model for the challenges facing the health sector.

We are aligning our intentions with the Government's strategy for primary healthcare and the introduction of new ways of delivering healthcare in a community setting. We are

working with and supporting other healthcare providers in the development of business cases in response to the Government's 'Better, Sooner, More Convenient' primary healthcare initiative.

The breadth and depth of our community involvement

There are many in New Zealand who contribute financially and in-kind to our success. We are very grateful for the generosity of our many supporters, funders, donors, partners and our volunteers who give so generously of their time. Thank you all.

We take particular pleasure and pride in our partnership with ASB. We have been impressed that ASB staff have participated so fully in the partnership with passion, commitment, charity and purpose.

Te Ara Hato Hone – St John Pathway

We set out to continue improving our responsiveness to Māori and tikanga during the year, led largely by our Senior Cultural Advisor Bevan Tipene-Matua.

We created our Māori strategy *Te Ara Hato Hone – St John Pathway* to progress Māori recruitment and retention and links with Māori organisations. Bevan wrote the St John haka and waiata, publicly performed for the first time at the St John International Youth Festival

in Christchurch in January 2010. It is a source of tremendous sadness that tragically, Bevan drowned on 16 March while gathering paua near his home at Porongahau in Hawke's Bay. Takitini Taku Toa (St John haka) and Tenei Matou (St John waiata) are his lasting legacies to us and these now become part of our kaupapa as we progress *Te Ara Hato Hone*.

Our strategic outlook

St John will play a key role in the future of healthcare in New Zealand. We will continue to evolve and innovate to do that. New ways of working will become a reality for us and we will work even more in collaboration with other partners and funders. We are committed to contributing to the best possible health outcomes for New Zealanders for another 125 years.

In an exciting first for St John in New Zealand, and to celebrate 125 years of service to our community, a commemorative rose was launched at Future Care 2010.

Our regionally-based network continues to lead a strong and united programme to build local support for the St John Eye Hospital in Jerusalem.

Funds to support the Eye Hospital are generated through new and established activities, oblations and donations.

Luminis (Latin for light) was produced by world renowned rosarian Bob Matthews of Matthews Nurseries, Wanganui. Proceeds from the sale of Luminis will support the work of the Eye Hospital. 1,250 plants are available for sale in 2010, followed by 10,000 plants available for sale in the next growing season.

Recently, St John in New Zealand agreed to sponsor a member of the Eye Hospital staff. Sponsorship of a team member is a first for New Zealand and it is an exciting and significant step.

Over the next three years we will donate approximately \$65,000 to support theatre nurse Samia Yacoub. Committing to this sponsorship is a reflection of the growing support and wonderful generosity from our Eye Hospital supporters.

We can reflect with pride on the support that we contributed in 2009–2010. We can all be confident that we continue to make a meaningful contribution to the work of the Eye Hospital.

The Jerusalem-based team continues to care for patients at the Eye Hospital in Jerusalem and at static clinics in Gaza, Hebron and Anabta. In addition, the Mobile Outreach team travels to eight rural clinics each week, covering a wide rural territory.

The generous support that so many of you offer is warmly appreciated - thank you all.

A special highlight during the last year was the visit of the Grand Prior, His Royal Highness The Duke of Gloucester.

The Grand Prior invested 77 postulants at the Investiture service in the Christchurch Town Hall in May 2010.

Many guests from St John organisations around the world were also in New Zealand and we were pleased to have them participate in the Investiture service, making it a special and spectacular occasion for all involved.

An earlier Investiture service in July 2009, held in the Cathedral of Holy Trinity in Auckland, included the installation of our Chancellor, Garry Wilson, and admission or promotion of 55 postulants.

My responsibility as Registrar includes making sure the Roll of the Priory in New Zealand remains current. My thanks go to John Strachan who has an invaluable historical knowledge and has spent much time assisting me with this work over the last year.

There are also bravery and life saving medals and certificates that can be awarded as part of the Order of St John. These also begin with nomination and can be awarded to a St John member or any member of the public.

I want to congratulate everyone who has received St John honours and awards this year. Thank you for the work you do, and will continue to do each and every day, for the Order of St John in New Zealand.

Stories from our past have been re-discovered and shared in many ways as we celebrate our 125 year anniversary in New Zealand.

The release of the late Graeme Hunt's well researched book, *First to Care: 125 Years of the Order of St John in New Zealand*, was an opportunity to share and celebrate service that has been given by St John across New Zealand since 1885.

In Christchurch, St John members liaised with the Canterbury Museum to develop a wonderful exhibition of St John, showcasing the past 125 years. The commemorative display included a specially made reproduction of an early horse-drawn carriage ambulance.

We have initiated a project to develop sustainable ways to preserve and share extensive St John heritage material that is scattered around New Zealand. A small team has been assisting with this project.

One key part of the project was developing a central electronic record of all St John material available around the country. The archive teams have an electronic inventory of their material on the Hub (our St John intranet) and this will be expanded to include inventories of all St John historical information. We plan to make digital copies of much of the material, so it can be accessed by everyone.

It is always a challenge to store and record heritage material appropriately so it will be available for future reference. The archives team in Northern Region produced a simple guide for members on how to look after and store heritage material – particularly

photographs and documents in private homes and St John venues.

Our intention is to develop a team of people throughout St John who are interested in our past and prepared to coordinate activity so we can make sure our history is recorded, stored and shared in the future.

The Service Medal of the Order of St John is unique as it is the only medal still issued that retains the image of Queen Victoria and the only one which has her facing to the right.

It was first awarded in New Zealand in 1908. Queen Victoria established the Order as a Royal Order of Chivalry with the Royal Charter of 1888.

The Service Medal is awarded for efficient service after 12 years, with a Bar to the Medal available for every subsequent five years of service. The Gilt Laurel Leaf was instituted in 2004 and is awarded after 52 years of service.

The Service Medal is accorded a place in the New Zealand Order of Wear: Orders, Decorations and Medals, approved by Her Majesty The Queen.
