St John is innovating to meet changing health and community needs.

St John's role as a professional healthcare and emergency services provider is evolving. St John is on a pathway that will transform ambulance services to ensure they continue to meet the needs of all New Zealanders. We are focused on achieving good community outcomes.

Future focused, resilient, sustainable

The legacy of the Canterbury earthquakes again focused the Priory Trust Board's attention this year. As well as highlighting the strength and resilience of our Canterbury members, out of the challenges have come new ideas for innovative ways of operating.

We now know more than ever the importance of locating our ambulance stations at sites likely to remain accessible through significant disaster. We recognise the need to have strong, resilient and new buildings to ensure the safety of our people and to meet our commitments as an accident and emergency healthcare provider.

Collaborating to care

St John's experience in Canterbury showed how valuable and important it is to collaborate with other first response services – Fire, Police, and other ambulance service providers – to facilitate the best patient care in times of real need.

Looking to the future, we value highly our partnership arrangements with the District Health Boards, PHOs, the Ministry of Health and the Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC), especially as we develop new emergency service options and new healthcare service models.

Celebrating achievement

That St John is one of New Zealand's most trusted and reliable brands and one of the top three most reputable not for profit organisations and that paramedics are among the most trusted professions, remains an honour and delight.

This year we celebrated the wonderful achievements of many hundreds of volunteers who contributed thousands of hours, specifically to the Friends of the Emergency Department (FEDs) and Caring Caller services. Both celebrated significant anniversaries during the past year. The FEDs started 10 years ago and now more than 800 people lend a valuable helping hand in the emergency departments of most public hospitals. Caring Caller marked 15 years of service this year. Our members also supported the resounding success of our biggest national sporting event, Rugby World Cup 2011. Their effort was exceptional.

Leadership talent changes

In August 2011 we were delighted to welcome His Excellency Lt Gen The Rt Hon Sir Jerry Mateparae as our Prior, the highest leadership role in our organisation. I also pay tribute to the very wise Don Hunn who retired from the Priory Trust Board in May 2012. I thank outgoing Chief Executive Jaimes Wood for his strong contribution during the past 12 and a half years and welcome Peter Bradley to the role. Peter has extensive experience managing the biggest ambulance service provider in the United Kingdom, the London Ambulance Service.

Developing and growing partnerships and collaborations in health is a key strategy for us.

St John is trusted and respected, well-organised and well-prepared to face the future challenges in healthcare.

Introducing transformational change

More demands are being placed on ambulance services as people are living longer and these demands are increasingly challenging to sustain. Simply providing patient ambulance transfer services to hospitals is becoming too costly, increasing hospital workloads and – most importantly – not necessarily providing the best patient outcomes.

To address these issues this year we launched a bold and innovative programme involving fundamental change to our ambulance delivery model.

As the emergency specialist in the health sector, and with patient numbers growing, an ageing population and limited money, we will transform our service delivery model, innovate and integrate our services with our health partners in a way that is sustainable for the country.

Stakeholder, customer and community engagement

Developing and growing partnerships and collaborations in health is a key strategy for us. We recognise that we need to understand and be understood by all organisations that contribute to a well-functioning health system and to appreciate the experience and expertise that others can bring to our work.

Meanwhile, it is pleasing that we are now on the Government's radar as a key and strategic player in the health sector through our partnerships with the Ministry of Health, ACC, and the District Health Boards, and through strengthening our responsiveness to Māori with Te Ara Hato Hone – St John Pathway – which was taken a step further when I signed the MoU with Te Puni Kōkiri as we ended the financial year.

Our organisational improvements

We continually seek solid solutions to further unify our organisation and take it forward. It is heartening that so many of our members believe that we have made great progress in recent times.

We have proved that we can change quickly and effectively, and I hope everyone continues to embrace change – as the organisation continues to evolve – capturing every benefit we sensibly can from being contemporary and linked to external partners in health and the community. My constant message to our people in my time with St John has been “keep going out every day and work hard to earn the continuing trust and respect of the public, and never become complacent. We must work to earn that trust every day.”

Thanks and farewell

Looking back on the 12 and a half years that I have been Chief Executive, I am extraordinarily proud of what has been achieved, and I will always be an advocate for this incredible organisation that provides so much value for New Zealand communities.

The St John Eye Hospital Group (SJEHG) has operated in one of the world's most unpredictable regions for 130 years.

In the 2011 calendar year 107,105 patients were seen and treated by our hospital, clinic and mobile outreach teams in Jerusalem and surrounding rural areas; 35,986 of those patients were under the age of 18. Care is often delivered against highly challenging and difficult odds.

During the year eight overseas doctors, including Dr Neil Pollock of Palmerston North, volunteered at the St John Eye Hospital in Jerusalem.

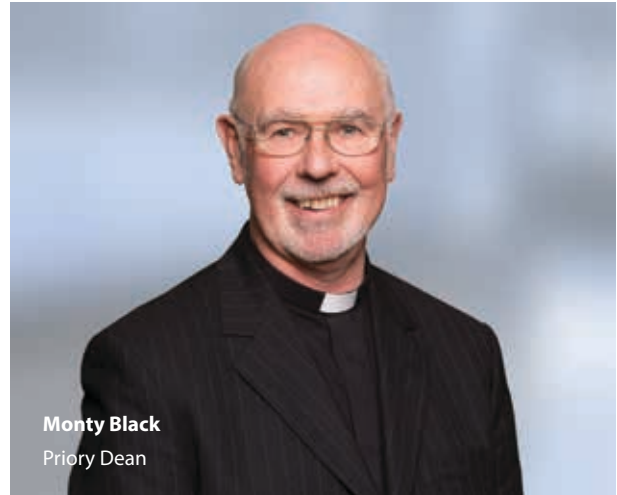
The generosity shown by New Zealanders in support of SJEHG continues to grow. I am immensely grateful for your support which assists the continuing provision of ophthalmology in an area where preventable blindness is ten times more prevalent than in the West. Generous individual and group donations, creative fundraising initiatives and oblations gifting from Order Members have all contributed to the New Zealand support.

New Zealand also contributed by continuing sponsorship for one of the 84 nurses, Samia Yacoub. In addition we agreed to sponsor a nursing accommodation building renovation that is currently underway at a cost of \$NZ65,000.

The SJEHG still relies on voluntary income as the major source of funding. Every dollar we generate to support them is guaranteed to improve the quality of life for a patient.

The work of the SJEHG is not simply a salve; it is most importantly helping to put people on their feet economically. While our services address individual suffering, they also provide significant social and economic benefits.

This is my first year as Dean and I am conscious that I have big shoes to fill following my predecessors, The Rev Dr Simon Rae and The Very Rev Dr Warren Limbrick, who laid the foundations for chaplaincy in St John.

The number of chaplains continues to grow with more than 50 nationwide. Since July 2012 we have welcomed eight new Area Chaplains.

The team is led by The Rev Bob Tremewan (South Island Region), The Ven David van Oeveren (Central Region) and The Rev Mark Sullivan who recently picked up the lead in Northern Region.

St John chaplains have begun to meet annually in conference. They have found this to be a most helpful way to develop a sense of collegiality, to learn more about the St John culture, and to ensure that we are working with a common understanding of chaplaincy.

The restructuring of St John to three regions has had a significant impact on how we organise chaplaincy. This will be an important focus for the leadership team for the remainder of this calendar year.

As Priory Dean I am working at visiting each of the regions at least once a year to discuss chaplaincy issues. I appreciated the opportunity to attend the Central Region's Area Committee Conference held in Napier in March 2012 and the chance to talk about the role of chaplaincy in St John.

I am very grateful for the support chaplaincy has received from our outgoing Chief Executive Jaimes Wood, and wish him God's blessings as he moves into a new season of his life.

During the last year a total of 85 postulants were acknowledged and received their awards at investiture services in Invercargill and Auckland.

The Order Roll as at the end of June 2012 stands at 1,680 members across all grades of the Order of St John.

A highlight of the year was the award of the Life Saving Medal of the Order in Bronze to Katrina Rowley for her outstanding bravery in Wanganui on 15 May 2011. It has been 10 years since this medal was awarded to a New Zealander.

Chapter is keen to see both the number and the quality of nominations increase. Our Order is unusual in that admission or promotion, whilst recognising significant past contribution, should also recognise a person's potential to continue to contribute to the work of St John. This presents an opportunity for the nomination of younger members, which we want to encourage.

The investing of members into the Order of St John is one of the most important ceremonies in the Order. The ceremony dates back to the establishment of the mediaeval Order of St John 900 years ago.

This year some enhancements have been introduced into the St John investiture service to better reflect our New Zealand identity. One important change is ensuring the use of both national anthems conform to state protocols.

Changes have also been introduced in the dinner associated with the investiture services, to ensure that the focus is on celebrating those who have been selected by their peers to be admitted or promoted in the Order.

An Assistant Director of Ceremonies is based in each Region to provide on-the-ground support for our national events, including investiture services and meetings of the Priory's Chapter. The assistants are Dennis Dufty (Northern Region), Harmen Van Weerden (Central Region) and Ian Rae (South Island Region).

Regional Order Matters Coordinators also provide support for our other ceremonies including church services, the dedication of vehicles and buildings and awards ceremonies. The Coordinators provide advice on the drafting of programmes and the protocols needed to ensure our ceremonial activity is of the standard that Chapter expects and is both respected and respectful.

I would like to end by extending my thanks to our Chief Executive, Jaimes Wood, who has done so much to help demystify our Order in contemporary New Zealand.

GRAND PRIOR'S AWARD



The Grand Prior's Award is the premier St John Youth award and is presented to cadets after the completion of 12 badges.

The Grand Prior's Award is represented by a badge. It is awarded to cadets who have successfully completed six compulsory badges (St John, First Aid, Caregivers, Communication, Community Awareness and Drill) and six badges of their choice at gold level.

The Grand Prior's Award was instituted in 1931 and New Zealand cadets were among the very first St John members worldwide to achieve the Grand Prior's Award in 1933.

The Service Medal of the Order of St John is unique as it is the only medal still issued that retains the image of Queen Victoria and the only one which has her facing to the right. It was first awarded in New Zealand in 1908.

The Service Medal is awarded for efficient service after 12 years, with a bar to the medal available for every subsequent five years of service. The Gilt Laurel Leaf was instituted in 2004 and is awarded after 52 years of service.

The Service Medal is accorded a place in the New Zealand Order of Wear: Orders, Decorations and Medals, approved by The Queen.
